Enhancing Transit - \$3 million for the Sierra Madre Villa Intermodal Center on the Gold Line to enhance transit services throughout the district.




Helping our Children - \$600,000 for Los Angeles County Office of Education Early Advantage program to provide resources and training for parents and their children in Covina.

On January 20, 2003, Congresswoman Solis was awarded the Ghandi, King, Ikeda Peace Award for her commitment to human rights.

The award was presented during an event organized by the West Covina Chamber of Commerce and the San Gabriel Valley Chapter of the NAACP that commemorated the birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. "Everything you have done for the betterment of people makes this world a better place...and enables you to actuate the dream," said West Covina Supervising Attorney Linda C. Johnson upon presenting the award to the Congresswoman.

SOLIS NAMED TO KEY POSITIONS IN THE HOUSE

Congresswoman Solis was appointed to the powerful House Energy and Commerce Committee in January. As a member of the committee, Solis is involved on issues such as Medicare prescription drug benefit, energy issues in California, and students' access to computers.

In February, Solis was elected Democratic Vice-Chair of the Congressional Caucus on Women's Issues for the 108th Congress. As such, she will be able to advocate for the rights of all women in the areas of women's health, economic equity, education, domestic violence, childcare, international women's issues, and many more.

"I hope to use my positions to increase access to quality health care and to clean up pollution that threatens the health of our community," said Solis. "I will be an advocate for the unique needs of families in the San Gabriel Valley and East Los Angeles."
